## JESUS, I LOVE YOU

Our readings this weekend are very appropriate for our celebration for St. Kateri. There is a reminder for all of us to seek God in the ordinary events of our lives. This reminder is a personal one. What inspires us about St. Kateri that challenges us to think, "I can do that?" God calls all of us to be saints. We are unique in our experiences in life, in our special gifts and talents, and in the way in which we respond to the challenges that life offers us. The book of Deuteronomy reminds us to "heed the voice of the Lord, your God." Saint Paul reminds the Colossians that "Jesus Christ is the head of the body, the Church." The Gospel of Luke speaks to us of how to seek eternal life by being merciful to self and to others. Looking at the life of St. Kateri, we can see how she listened to the voice of God in her heart; how she truly saw the grace of God at work, not only in herself but also in the responses of others to her example, her words, and actions. We admire and ask for help from St. Kateri in our own lives. God does not want us to be another St. Kateri. He already has one! God wants us to be the saint He created us to be. We can use St. Kateri as a model and guide to better "heed the voice of the Lord, your God, to respect God who dwells in us and others, to be reminded to be merciful. St. Kateri's last words before she died, "Jesus, I love you," can truly be our guide and inspiration, our road map to heaven. You can inspire another to see the goodness that dwells within them by seeing the goodness in yourself. Be inspired this weekend. Look at your own life situation. Do not be afraid to say, "Jesus, I love You." Respond to the voice of God in your heart by telling yourself, "I can do that."

**Masses will take place the last weekend of every month.**



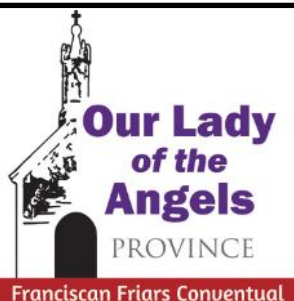
