weekend of every month.



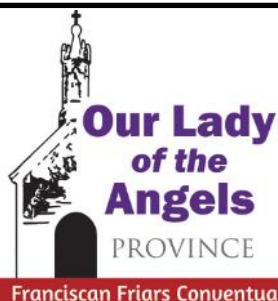
